You can receive a free kit of cloth diapers with everything you need to be successful with cloth. Licensed foster families can request diapers to keep on hand for future placements. Each kit includes a mix of styles and brands, so that you can find what works for you.

Your kit will include the following:

- 24 diaper changes
- 6 extra liners/prefolds for extra absorbance or nighttime
- 48 reusable flannel wipes
- Cloth diaper pail liner or wet bag
- Travel wet bag for on the go
- Detergent

Save Money

NOT YOUR GRANDPARENT'S CLOTH DIAPERS

Modern cloth diapers have come a long way, offering families a wide array of options. Today's cloth diapers are equipped with breathable, water-resistant PUL material, user-friendly fasteners, and a range of natural and synthetic fabrics. Some even come as all-in-one options, simplifying the process and making cloth diapers more convenient than ever before.

CLOTH DIAPER CARE IS SIMPLE

Washing cloth diapers isn't intimidating: they are just very dirty laundry. They can be washed at home. Once you find your rhythm it's not hard.

Cloth diaper wash routines require only a few steps:

- 1.Dispose of any solids into the toilet.
- 2. Store soiled diapers in a dry pail or a wetbag until wash day. Wash every 1-2 days, at least.
- 3. (Optional) Run a shorter cycle with a small amount of detergent to remove the heaviest soil.
- 4. Select your washer's longest heavy duty cycle with the full recommended amount of detergent for heavily soiled laundry.
- 5. Finally, dry your diapers (hang dry or in a machine).



COMMON CONCERNS

Don't have a washer?We can help you hand wash.

Worried about detergent?

Most mainstream detergents are great for cloth, so no need to buy a special, expensive detergent.

You can use any diaper cream with cloth diapers!
If you choose something petroleum based, avoid repelling issues by using a liner with synthetic fiber diapers.
